

ORCID Incentive Competition – Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 (“Curtin University”).
5. The ORCID Incentive Competition (“the competition”) commences at 9am Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on Monday, 22 October 2018.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 5pm AWST on Friday 23 November 2018, or until prizes are all awarded.
7. Entry to the competition is limited to Curtin academic staff who have registered for an ORCID and connected their ORCID to the Elements system.
8. To enter the competition, the entrant must create a new ORCID account or connect their existing ORCID through Elements <https://elements.curtin.edu.au/login.html>
9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
10. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
11. There will be twenty-five (25) prizes. This prize will be a prize pack comprising a coffee voucher, ORCID branded ceramic mug, vinyl sticker, and badges.
12. There will be five (5) draws at 10am Australian Western Standard Time every Tuesday between 22 October 2018 and 23 November 2018 at Curtin University T.L. Roberson Library, Building 105, Kent Street, Bentley, Western Australia, 6102. The draw will be by random number generator from a system report of ORCID's connected in Elements created every Monday.
13. The prize winner will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw by the email address listed in the Curtin staff directory.
14. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within seven (7) days of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within fourteen (14) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method. Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
15. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner's parent or legal guardian.
16. The prize may be collected in person by the prize winner or may be mailed.
17. If a prize winner who has been contacted and been made aware of their prize winning, and has agreed to collect the prize or for which collection is the only method for receiving the prize, does not collect the prize within seven (7) days of this contact, a re-draw will be conducted within fourteen (14) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.
18. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their parent or legal guardian, may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport) when receiving the prize.
19. The prize winner will be responsible for all costs associated with collecting and using the prize.

20. By entering the competition the entrant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
